Eligibility

For Junior members born on or after January 1, 2012. This form can be computer simulated but must follow exact format as presented. Six semifinalists will be selected based on the Entry Book and interviewed at the annual PA Jr. Holstein Convention. Entries are due to the PHA Office by January 1st. If you have any questions, call the PA Holstein Association at (814) 234-0364.

The Entry Book

The entry book should be prepared carefully, neatly typed, and present a true story of the contestant and his/her work in the Junior Holstein Association. Materials should be accurate and complete. Records should not contain filler materials as NO extra pages are permitted to be added to this book. The entry must be done in an easy to read, 12-point font, with one-inch margins and double-spaced, unless otherwise noted.

A. Front and Back Cover

Books must be in a 3-ring notebook. Covers will not be judged. Photos on the front and back covers are acceptable. Be creative.

B. Divider Pagers

Divider pages must contain tabs. Divider pages can be used to demonstrate your creativity and personality for each section of your entry book. Photos can be used on these pages-limited to one side only. Nothing should be placed on the back side of the divider pages.

C. Introductory Page

One photo must be mounted on this page along with the name, age, birth date, and complete address of the applicant.

D. Personal Holstein Project Summary

This attached form must be completed, signed, and inserted in application as Section D.

E. Story of Junior Holstein Work

Not to exceed 2 pages using 12-point font and double spaced, this story should emphasize your degree of involvement with your Registered Holsteins. Include your responsibilities on the farm and your involvement in Junior Holstein Activities.

F. Summary of Holstein Activities.

No maximum number of pages in this section. This section does not have to be double-spaced. List ALL your activities from the most recent year to your first year. Highlight your career thus far as a Junior Holstein member. Include shows, achievements, awards and leadership positions held. A suggested format is listed below.

This list may include the name of the animal, date of birth, sire, dam, and estimated value. If you would like to list all the animals you have owned and are no longer in your herd, it is recommended that you list them at the bottom of the page. Leased, partnership, and managerial animals should be listed under a separate heading.

I. Obtaining and Developing Animals

Limited to 1 page, this section must be double-spaced. Explain how your animals were obtained and financed and what you are doing to develop your herd. Also explain your breeding and mating program.

J. Clippings and Pictures about You

Limited to 4 pages, front only, the applicant should exhibit a variety of photos of Holstein, 4-H, community and school activities. Be creative!

K. Personal Views

Answer one of the following questions in one page, double-spaced or less. Please choose and answer only one of the questions. Points will be deducted for every exceeding one page.
