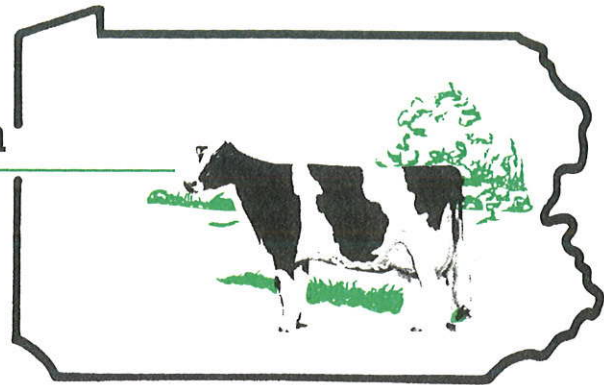

Dear Consignor:

Congratulations and welcome to the 20th Annual Delaware Valley University Green & Gold Sale, which will be held in the Equine Arena at Delaware Valley University, 108 Farm View Road, Doylestown, PA 18901 on **Saturday, April 6, 2019 at 11:00 a.m.** The Pennsylvania Holstein Association and members of the Delaware Valley University Dairy Society, sale co-managers, are very excited about this year's group of consignments. In order for the best possible presentation of your consignment(s) and for a smooth-running sale, we ask your cooperation on the following:

1) Please test all cattle as soon as possible **after March 13th and before March 22nd.** Out of state consignors, interstate to Delaware Valley Green & Gold Sale, Doylestown, PA. **Pennsylvania consignors need to secure a health chart.**

2) **All cattle regardless of age must have a negative TB test within 60 days of the sale.**

3) **A negative brucellosis test must be made within 30 days of the sale.**

**\*\* CATTLE FROM CERTIFIED and ACCREDITED HERDS MUST BE BRUCELLOSIS AND TB TESTED REGARDLESS OF HERD STATUS\*\***

4) **All cattle must be tested for BVD using the Antigen capture test, the BVD ear notch test or the virus isolation test.** Pennsylvania Holstein Association's Board of Directors instituted this as a policy for the Association's consignment sales. We have found this to be a test that many of our domestic cattle buyers are requesting and feel it will add value to our sale cattle as well.

5) All cattle shall have been vaccinated against BVD at least twice during the past six months. The most recent inoculation shall be no less than 15 days and no more than 45 days. BVD vaccine may be part of multivalent vaccine again shipping fever. Consult your veterinarian if necessary.

6) It is recommended that consignments be vaccinated in the current year again the respiratory complex (shipping fever), including IBR, not less than 15 days prior to arrival or have been administered a prophylactic dose of hyperimmune IBR - Shipping Fever Serum within 5 days of arrival.

7) If your animal(s) is/are calfhood vaccinated, please be sure this is noted on the health chart or send the vaccination report with the consignment.

8) **All consignments should arrive at the holding barn – 108 Farm View Lane, Doylestown, PA on Monday, April 1 – Tuesday, April 2.** We are attaching the list of consignors for your reference to possibly combine trucking.




- 9) Please be sure to send the **registration certificate, signed transfer and health chart** with your consignment.
  - 10) Please send with your consignment, the **DHIA Lactation Transfer** for cows with a lactation in progress, or with animals that have completed records. Also, send any updated information such as breeding or freshening dates that do not appear in the catalog.
  - 11) Every effort has been made to provide accurate, up-to-date information on each consignment in the catalog. Please check the pedigree on your consignment carefully, if any errors or omissions are discovered, please bring them to our attention.
  - 12) If for any reason a lactating consignment has received Combiotic or any other antibiotic within a few days of shipping to the sale, please send a report with the animal(s). **This is very important, as milk from these animals must be discarded.**
  - 13) Individual care of your consignment is not necessary, as feeding, watering and milking will be done by the barn crew.
  - 14) Please clip the head of your consignment. The sale crew will complete the clipping (shoulders, backs, udders, etc.).
  - 15) **All animals should be halter broken and trained to lead.**
  - 16) Some consignments have freshened since they were selected. We would encourage consignors to send heifer calves to sell with their dams.
  - 17) Sale Commission Rates: 15% Commission on the first \$3,500  
 5% Commission over \$3,501  
 10% Commission on the additional animals consigned from the same farm  
 (15% on the high seller, 10% on all other animals)  
 10% Commission on Embryo Packages
- Checks will be mailed within 30 days of the sale with EXCEPTION of those entries that do not have completed paperwork to sale management.**

**2019 DELAWARE VALLEY GREEN AND GOLD SALE  
VETERNARIAN CHECKLIST  
TESTING AND VACCINATION WORK**

**Please test all cattle between March 13th and March 22nd**

**All cattle must be tested regardless of whether they originated from a certified and accredited herd. Some states do not accept cattle on a certified and accredited basis, so they must be tested.**

- Required:** All cattle regardless of age must have a negative TB test within 60 days of April 6, 2019.
- Required:** A negative brucellosis test must be made within 30 days of April 6, 2019.
- Required:** All cattle must be tested for BVD using the BVD ACE or Antigen Capture test or BVD virus isolation. Pennsylvania Holstein Association's Board of Directors instituted this as a policy for the Association's consignment sales. We have found this to be a test that many of our domestic cattle buyers are requesting and feel it will add value to our sale cattle as well.

It is recommended that consignments be vaccinated in the current year again the respiratory complex (shipping fever), including IBR, not less than 15 days prior to departure or have been administered a prophylactic dose of hyperimmune IBR Shipping Fever Serum within 5 days of departure.

**We recommend the following tests:** Leucosis, Anaplasmosis, Johnes and Neospora.

**Identify the animal on health chart with one of these two "Official" identification number types: 840 series tags; i.e. 840003001002911 or state series metal tags; i.e. 23ABC1234**
