

**Please use this while your vet is present!!**

**2019 EASTERN ELITE SALE  
VETERINARIAN CHECKLIST  
TESTING AND VACCINATION WORK**

**Please test all cattle BEFORE September 6<sup>th</sup>.**

All cattle must be tested regardless of whether they originated from a certified and accredited herd. Some states do not accept cattle on a certified and accredited basis, so they must be tested!

**PLEASE MAKE A SEPARATE HEALTH CHART FOR EACH CONSIGNMENT!**

Each Consignment must have **an 840 RFID tag** put in the ear of the animal

**Identify the animal on health chart with the “Official” identification number: 840 series tags; i.e. 840003001002911**

- ❑ **Required:** All cattle regardless of age must have a negative TB test within 60 days of the sale
- ❑ **Required:** A negative brucellosis test must be made within **30** days of the sale on all sale animals.
- ❑ **Required:** All cattle must be tested for BVD using the BVD ACE or Antigen Capture test or BVD virus isolation. Pennsylvania Holstein Association's Board of Directors instituted this as a policy for the Association's consignment sales. We have found this to be a test that many of our domestic cattle buyers are requesting and feel it will add value to our sale cattle as well.

We **recommend** a Leucosis, Johnes, Neospora, and Anaplasmosis test on your animal, please advise the Sale Management of the results. Several potential buyers for cows and bred heifers have requested negative cattle for these diseases.
